WILLIAM REED HAWN (Chief of Royal Guards) Reed is making his debut performance in the Zilker Summer Musical. He is a graduating senior from the University of Texas with a degree in Radio/Television/Film, Speech and Government. Mr. Hawn has been involved in performance for the past nine years.

ROBIN HUSTON (Narrator) Robin is appearing in her second Zilker Summer Musical after last being seen in WEST SIDE STORY.
