





2001 Deacon Crain Award

The Deacon Crain Award is given by Zilker Theatre Productions to individuals who have given longstanding service and support for the summer musical. Receiving the Deacon Crain Award is truly an accomplishment. Deacon Crain performed in the summer musical during its early years and then served on the Board of Directors of the Friends of the Summer Musical (now ZTP) from 1987 until his death in 1998. The summer musical in Zilker Park at the Beverly S. Sheffield Hillside Theatre is an Austin tradition. The Will Rogers Follies – A Life in Revue is the 43rd annual presentation of a Broadway musical, offered with free admission to the public. This is a record unmatched anywhere else in the United States. The tradition continues because of dedicated people like the former and present recipients of the Deacon Crain Award. It is the pleasure of Zilker Theatre Productions to announced Lloyd D. Storm and his late wife Arlene Storm as the 2001 recipients of the Deacon Crain Award in recognition of their years of dedicated service and support for the summer musical.

Over the past decade there has been no crisis for the musical that the Storms did not help to resolve. The Storms have not only provided financial support to the summer musical, but also gifts of their time, their energies, their expertise, and their hospitality. Arlene served a term on the Zilker Board of Directors as Secretary. They have organized many Rehearsathons and arranged for the prizes for the intermission drawings on the Hillside. The Storms were also familiar faces on the Hillside. No job was ever too big or too small that the Storms were not willing to perform. Lloyd and Arlene could be found during almost every performance in or around the concession stand, selling T-shirts, passing out programs, collecting donations, or wherever else their help was needed.

ZTP is grateful to the Storms for the countless volunteer hours they have dedicated to the Zilker Summer Musical over the years. Though the years, they have personified the attitude that the "the show must go on," and so it has. Our thanks to Arlene and Lloyd Storm! We note with particular sadness that Arlene Storm passed away in April of this year. She will be genuinely missed by this community.








The Will Rogers Follies - A Life in Revue has been a thrilling experience for the company of actors, designers, the production team, and supporting staff. Having a musical based on an individual who gave so much of himself to the world has been quite humbling. When I first received the directorial assignment, I immediately read Will Rogers biography, which I found most helpful and inspirational. The first time I read the script, the ending brought tears to my eyes. During rehearsals, the final moments always find me "weepy" as it does so many times in the show.

The Will Rogers Follies - A Life in Revue, a 1991 Tony award winning show weaves a narrative around Ziegfeld Follies-like production numbers. The story is set in the present at the Palace Theatre in New York City, and told in flashbacks. Will Rogers worked at the Palace Theatre during the Ziegfeld Follies years. The play accounts his life, from birth until death. You will meet his father, Clem, his wife, Betty, his four children, his friend Wiley Post, and Florence Ziegfeld, his boss at the Palace Theatre. To help narrate the story, there is a chorus of Cowboys and Ziegfeld Showgirls. This includes Mr. Ziegfeld's Favorite, who acts as a Mistress of Ceremonies. There is also a Wild West Show, with animals, and several numbers are staged, as they were by Ziegfeld himself at the Palace Theatre. All of the events that occur in the play are historically accurate, so you will leave the hillside with a mini-history lesson.

The company of the production team and artists has been a great group to work with. We feel that Will Rogers would have been proud that we reached out to our community with love. Hopefully, you the audience on the hillside will know that we have expressed love for our craft and that we so appreciate you. We hope everyone will walk away from the hillside this summer a richer person for the experience of The Will Rogers - A Life in Revue. We hope you will enjoy the experience of The Will Rogers Follies as much as we have enjoyed putting it all together!



Chris is making his first appearance with Zilker Theatre Productions. He is currently a senior at UT completing his BA degree in Theatre and Dance. He has appeared


















Diana Eve Wheeler Ziegteld's Favorite, Betty Blake Understudy, Dance Captain
















Karin Chekirda Ensemble

Demond is making his Zilker debut with The Will Rogers Follies. He has appeared in several Southwest Texas State University productions including




Desiree L. Hall Ensemble
















Taylor McPhail Mary Rogers





Dennis Whitehead


Music Director
