



The Hillside Theatre now boasts new stamped and stained lighted pathways and terracing to provide safe access for all, expanded walking surfaces, a new stage floor, new underground conduit for sound and electrics cables, assorted electrical, plumbing, sound, and structural improvements, much needed safety upgrades and

stabilization and protection of the onstage historic ash tree. With **John Faulk** at the helm, ZTP worked with the City of Austin and many generous individuals and companies from the private sector to accomplish these many improvements for this very special Austin venue.


